Current required works at Gossmore Toilets

September 2023

There are multiple works required at Gossmore public toilet block as follows:

Electrics

We have had an electrician visit the toilet block to review the electrics following a number of leaks that affected the utility room where the fuse box is. The advice is that the fuse box should be changed. The box is rusty.

Cost £1200

We have also been advised that the fans and lights should be changed as the fans are ineffective and contributing to the mould problem in the block.

Cost £600

Handwash Units

We have 3 units, 2 in the female toilets and 1 in the male unit. The electrician has confirmed there are no RCD breakers in them. This means that they are potentially hazardous as there is no protection from electric shock should the right conditions occur. Now we know this we ought to change all the units. The market is tiny to non existent. I got two quotes and they are both for the same THRii machines. One unit was approved at the April TC Meeting. The cost below is for 2 units.

Cost £7,500

Legionella Remedial works

We recently had a legionella safety assessment of both the changing rooms and the toilet block. There were multiple recommendations that must be done. The report is available as required. Following a number of quotes, the cost to rectify concerns is £1,800. There was no legionella bacteria present in the water supply at either building.

Cost £1,800

Mould on the ceiling and walls

A deep clean is required due to the black mould on the ceilings. This has got particularly bad in every unit following a significant water leak, broken fans and closure of the toilet due to no handwashing facilities meaning that there was no ventilation. There are mushrooms growing on the wall and black mould on the ceilings.

Cost £600

From a Health & Safety perspective all these works are necessary.

Total cost £11,700
