Queens Jubilee Event June 3rd, 2022

The Community Committee proposes an event in Higginson Park on Friday 3 June to celebrate the Queen’s Platinum Jubilee.

Named “Party like the Queen”. The park will be open to everyone to come in and join in a day of celebration. The day will include family entertainment for all ages, based on a 1950’s theme. There will be music, food and drink stalls, entertainment and vintage cars and residents can bring their own picnics. A detailed event plan is being drawn up with the day starting at 11.00am and finishing at 5pm. The proposal is for a break-even budget, already included in the 2022/23 budget and an additional spend of up to £5,000 is recommend to be taken to full Council for approval to come from the predicted surplus on the 2020/21 Budget.

RESOLVED
