




I have attached a copy of the Society's Position Statement on the projected Marlow Film Studio. This is based on the feedback from many of you. The vast majority of you rejected the proposals that Dido Property Ltd has put into the public domain.

I would like to remind you that the effort expended by Dido to justify their case far exceeds that for any planning application in Marlow that we have ever seen. This includes:

- Three "informal discussions" in 2021 with the most senior planning officers of Buckinghamshire Council for which no minutes or notes were taken as a record.
- · Five on line Community Liaison meetings.
- Briefing the Bucks Council Economic Recover Group.
- Briefing the Marlow Chamber of Trade and Commerce.
- A site visit by the Bucks Council Economic Recover Group.
- Exhibitions in Liston Court.
- A briefing of local Parish and County councillors.

All this in an attempt to persuade Marlovians that the loss of Green Belt land and the social impact of a site employing some 3000 workers will be of benefit to us all.

As a Marlow resident of 29 years I want to express my deepest concern at the proposals for a film studio development on green belt land to the east of Marlow.

This land is designated as green belt and a country park. It is a vital area of wild land between developments of Marlow, Little Marlow and Bourne End.

I am deeply distressed to hear this land referenced as wasteland and even a landfill site. In the near 30 years I have been here it has always been wild meadows and lakes with trees and hedgerows.

As a regular birdwatcher and visitor to this area I have observed wildlife here at its best. This area supports iconic British wildlife including: kingfishers, barn owls, kestrels, great crested and little grebe. There are many species of duck wintering on the lakes, as well as swans and geese. There are rabbits, foxes, mice, voles and moles. The area supports wild plants, butterflies and insects. Many of these species cannot tolerate destruction or disturbance of their habitat.

In short this development will destroy a key part of the British countryside and wildlife at a time when anyone with sense is seeking to preserve our diminishing wildlife. How can we applaud Earthshot, how can we ask Africans to protect Rhinos, Lions and other animals, how can we ask countries to preserve rainforest when we are prepared to allow developers to concrete over vast swathes of our remains green land, when there are ample brownfield sites throughout our country.

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

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
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
