I note from your application that you wish to display Lidl's logo / name within the requested sign. Unfortunately, this is not permitted on traffic signs placed on the public highway – the Department for Transport advises that it is not the function of such signs to serve as an advertisement and that such logos / commercial names must not be used.

The residents are requesting a change to parking to incorporate bays available to residents at all times, but with limited time parking to other users. Some years ago, possibly around 12, Buckinghamshire Council employed Halcrow to carry out a parking review for Marlow. As I recall, their recommendations were to set a controlled area for parking which affected the whole town up to, in some cases, up to half a mile form the town centre as a way of addressing displacement parking. If I recall correctly, the Town Council and the Marlow Society rejected the proposals on the basis that they might affect the vibrancy of the Town. One of the arguments now being put forward by residents is that the world has now changed, particularly following Covid, and there are now more people working from home, which has increased local space demand.

The Town Council is still not in favour of the introduction of further residents only parking restrictions to protect the vibrancy of the Town and Neil and I do not accept the residents' argument that you can introduce such parking in only a few streets (up to 8 currently suggested).

It would be helpful to understand BC's current view on residents' only parking and what the procedures and costs would to consider it. Could you please let us know the name of one of your officers with whom we could discuss this with a view to reporting back to residents.

Liston Court development

I am writing to express my great concern about the current, unnecessary, over development of Liston Court. This concern is based on a number of issues:

The first is that there was, as far as I am aware, no consultation with the people of Marlow, as to whether they wanted this development to take place. I saw no planning notices or other notification, despite passing through the Court every day. The first I, or any other member of the public, knew about the development, was the erection of placards on the Friday before the Monday that work commenced. I witnessed many people looking at the notices and almost literally scratching their heads in disbelief. I would like to know, therefore, why this was sanctioned and carried out in such secrecy, and by whom.

Secondly, the images on the placards were highly misleading. It is only in the last few days that I have seen the scale of the new paving that is being laid. Almost the entire area, that was previously grass, to the left of the main pathway, i.e. around the yew trees, has now been paved. This is shown as still grassed in the images. Actually, I consider this degree of destruction, sheer vandalism. The grass is pleasant, cooling, reduces runoff, and allows birds, and other wildlife, sanction and feeding space. It represents green space, for people, and for animals. Most of this has now gone. It is being replaced by an urban desert.

Thirdly, the whole development is overblown. This is a crude attempt at populism. Whoever sanctioned this piece of work (see four below), clearly thinks this is what people want. That it will attract more people, and therefore more business. Perhaps it will but perhaps, in this case, it is not what is required or wanted. Liston Court is a quiet and relatively secluded area in the centre of the town, which people value for the very reason it is quiet and tranquil. I understand that more benches and fixed tables are to be installed. My view is that this will destroy the nature and purpose of this important piece of the town. The grass was perfectly adequate, and appropriate, for people who wished to sit for a short space of time, or picnic. Fixed benches and tables will entirely change the nature and use of the space. They will attract noise, vapers, latenight drinking and litter. This is not Higginson Park. It serves an entirely different purpose.

Fourthly, I want to raise questions about how this whole development was sanctioned, including the finances behind it. As far as I am aware, the land belongs to Bucks County Council, but the work is clearly being financed by other sources, presumably Sorbonne Estates. This seems a strange arrangement to me. I wonder who initiated the work, and why. Clearly someone thinks they are going to benefit or profit from the development. I do not think that will be the people of Marlow.

In summary, this is work that has been foisted on us by stealth, by people who clearly see an opportunity to profit in some way. While the area arguably needed some renovation, particularly the brickwork of the paths, this is a massive piece of over-development which will, and has

already, destroyed the nature and purpose of Liston Court. Whoever is responsible has used soft words like improved amenity, lighting and security, when they really mean creating more hard space, for more people, with an eye to creating a busy, commercialised centre that will change the nature of Liston Court as an important sanctuary for wildlife and nature generally, and a quiet space for people to enjoy, rest or pass through.

I would value your views on these observations, and also like to know what the view of Marlow Town Council is/was in relation to this development, and to what extent you were involved in the process that brought it about.

Little Marlow Parish Council would like to draw to your attention a letter submitted by Councillor Richard Scott of Marlow Town Council, to Buckinghamshire Council's Planning Authority, regarding application 22/06443/FULEA Marlow Film Studios (attached).

Councillor Scott submitted the letter as a "Member of the Public" and he states that its contents and stance represents the conclusions of an informal private meeting of Marlow Town Council members.

However, we are concerned that the letter has been interpreted as representing a formal resolution by Marlow Town Council, particularly as it is signed as "Councillor Richard Scott".

An article in the Daily Mail newspaper about the Film Studio justifies this concern (attached below).

"This, in turn, is one of the main reasons why Marlow Town Council last week decided to come in behind the studio plans, adding that the project should generate £750 million in inward investment and £338 million of local economic activity per year".

Little Marlow Parish Council requests that you review this matter to determine if the actions taken by Councillor Richard Scott and his fellow members have breached the code of conduct and brought Marlow Town Council into disrepute.




