Thank you for sharing this and as you will appreciate there has been involvement to date with the council in various discussions and presentation made to us on behalf of Dido properties as well as several of our Councillors involved recently in a site walkaround visit the week before last, councillors have also attended the "soundings " events that have sought consultation on behalf of Dido properties and dido are holding public information events in Liston court over the coming weekend .We can share the following with you on the history and involvement we have observed so far .

The council takes a similar position along with the chambers view that residents on the whole appear positive about this proposal given the long term benefits that would appear to apply to the majority that have expressed views as to the future prosperity of Marlow, particularly for the young and the schools who share a great enthusiasm for the project . I should point out however that small groups are actively against it in the context of biodiversity and the aspirations of a country park coveted by some, that appears to be in contention given that we are led to believe that was never formalised so, it is a legal discussion ongoing between landowners and BCC yet to be finalised delivered or formalised as an approved project or indeed funded.

In essence it's a Mexican standoff i.e. the park seems unable to be delivered unless dido agree to relinquishing its land for that ,on the other hand we believe they are proactively seeking a win win by enabling that through their development should those that have aspirations wish to enter into discussions .

The council in its public serving position as a consultee through planning will however continue to reserve judgement as until final details and a planning application actually comes forward, we are led to believe that will be at the end of the first quarter 2022 and we will continue to solicit views from all groups for and against as it goes to strategic planning and is reviewed by the secretary of state prior to finally commenting officially.

At the point an application goes public there will be the opportunity for all members of the public to put forward their view ,in the meantime Jocelyn and I would be happy to fill any gaps or questions to assist in sharing the proposals that have been shared with us so far as Cllr's or direct you to the appropriate Dido personnel.

### Have you had your say?

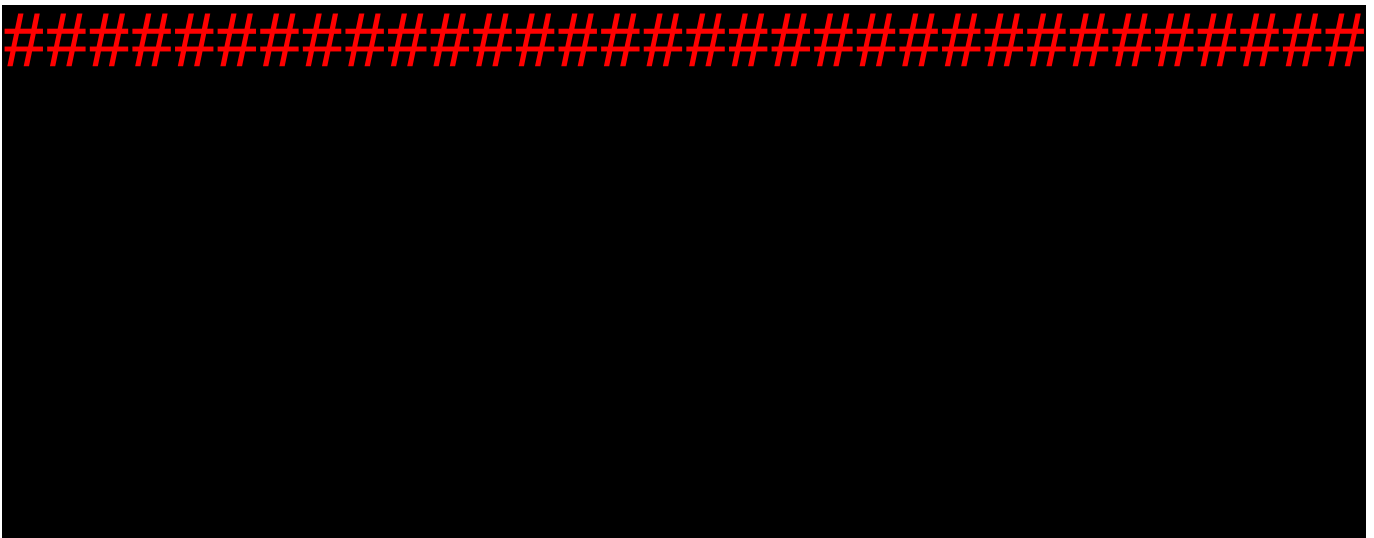

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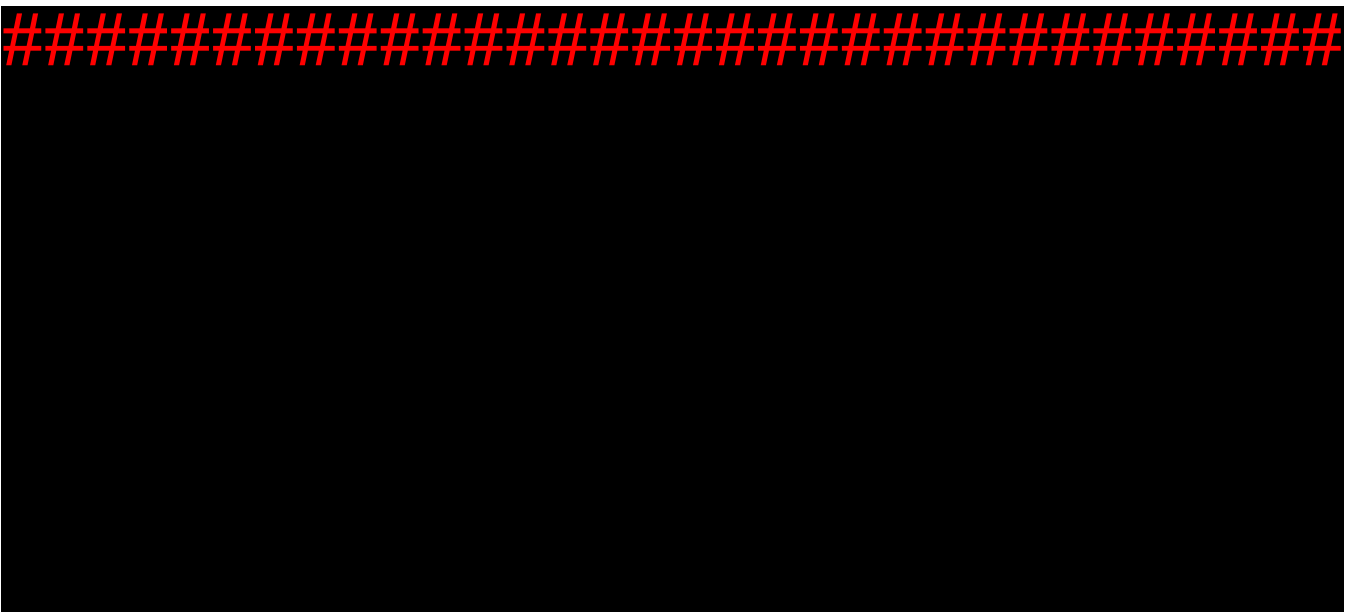

Yesterday I was unable to walk through the archway between Liston Garden and Liston Road. [REDACTED] contractors, working on the extension to the building in the courtyard, were delivering and stacking building material. I took the alternative route via the mud path to the east of the [REDACTED] land. A private vehicle was parked on this footpath.

I have previously brought to the attention of the MTC that this north - south mud path becomes excessively muddy after rain. It needs some back filling before winter at its southern end.

safe permanent footpath around the [REDACTED] site for pedestrians and especially those who use vehicles for the disabled?

Thank you for this.

Clearly the erection of a bandstand is not an instant fix. I had imagined that Higginson Park was owned in some kind of charitable trust but I didn't know that the Trustee was Buckinghamshire County Council. In stages therefore it would seem is the following necessary conditions

- (a) Bucks CC thinks this is a good idea and gets behind it
- (b) Funding is available for the planning designing & construction. That's where I come in - I am content to finance these elements myself or be a guarantor for the financing following a public appeal. That latter may garner wider support. I don't need recognition but I would want a strong voice in the design (and I am thinking very traditional "Victorian or Classical Style").
- (c) Planning permission would have to be obtained.
- (d) There would have to be 'buy-in' from not only a local brass band to ensure regular weekend use but musical and other entertainers to make sure it is vibrant and fully utilised.
- (e) A local public or charitable entity (not me) would have to commit to maintaining the structure out into the future. I could probably fund a modest pot to help defray expenses like this early on but to survive through time someone has to 'love' it.

I'm happy for you to bring this up in any forum you think is appropriate.

Your email of 27 February has been forwarded to me and I note your interesting suggestion about the possible provision of a bandstand in Higginson Park. I do know from my time as a councillor with Marlow Town Council that this suggestion has been put forward a number of times over recent years and it has not moved forward for a number of reasons.

The ownership of the land is with a trust the trustee of which is Buckinghamshire Council (previously Wycombe District Council). Therefore the trust would have to give its approval to any building erected in the park. As the park is utilised for a number of major events during the year using the whole of the park careful consideration would have to be given to the location of a bandstand. I suspect it would also need planning permission.

Enquiries would have to be made as to the cost of a bandstand and its surrounding landscaping and I suspect that there would have to be public fundraising for the project as it is not currently included in any medium term capital plans of Buckinghamshire Council; and it would probably be outside of the resources available from the town council. In addition there would be ongoing revenue costs of security and future repairs.

That said the proposal is worthy of further thought. Both Buckinghamshire Council and Marlow Town Council are just about to enter an election period and new council terms will begin in May. I suggest that I ask the Marlow Town Clerk to note the your suggestion and bring it back to the new town council to see if it can be taken forward. As I say the Town Council will first have to have the first conversation with Buckinghamshire Council as the trustees.

I or my successor as Mayor will come back to you after the elections in May.

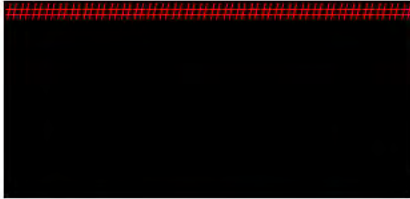

Thank you for this.

Clearly the erection of a bandstand is not an instant fix. I had imagined that Higginson Park was owned in some kind of charitable trust but I didn't know that the Trustee was Buckinghamshire County Council. In stages therefore it would seem is the following necessary conditions

- (a) Bucks CC thinks this is a good idea and gets behind it
- (b) Funding is available for the planning designing & construction. That's where I come in - I am content to finance these elements myself or be a guarantor for the financing following a public appeal. That latter may garner wider support. I don't need recognition but I would want a strong voice in the design (and I am thinking very traditional "Victorian or Classical Style").
- (c) Planning permission would have to be obtained.
- (d) There would have to be 'buy-in' from not only a local brass band to ensure regular weekend use but musical and other entertainers to make sure it is vibrant and fully utilised.
- (e) A local public or charitable entity (not me) would have to commit to maintaining the structure out into the future. I could probably fund a modest pot to help defray expenses like this early on but to survive through time someone has to 'love' it.

Your email of 27 February has been forwarded to me and I note your interesting suggestion about the possible provision of a bandstand in Higginson Park. I do know from my time as a councillor with Marlow Town Council that this suggestion has been put forward a number of times over recent years and it has not moved forward for a number of reasons.

The ownership of the land is with a trust the trustee of which is Buckinghamshire Council (previously Wycombe District Council). Therefore the trust would have to give its approval to any building erected in the park. As the park is

utilised for a number of major events during the year using the whole of the park careful consideration would have to be given to the location of a bandstand. I suspect it would also need planning permission.

Enquiries would have to be made as to the cost of a bandstand and its surrounding landscaping and I suspect that there would have to be public fundraising for the project as it is not currently included in any medium term capital plans of Buckinghamshire Council; and it would probably be outside of the resources available from the town council. In addition there would be ongoing revenue costs of security and future repairs.

That said the proposal is worthy of further thought. Both Buckinghamshire Council and Marlow Town Council are just about to enter an election period and new council terms will begin in May. I suggest that I ask the Marlow Town Clerk to note the your suggestion and bring it back to the new town council to see if it can be taken forward. As I say the Town Council will first have to have the first conversation with Buckinghamshire Council as the trustees.

I or my successor as Mayor will come back to you after the elections in May.

If we strive to build a broadly supported vision it must never be devoid of ambition or hollow and we have a duty to engage with all stakeholders within the community and educating our community and collaboration seems to be a sensible way to achieve our goals in harmony.

Our discussion ended up with a talk about pizzas and we arrived there as a demonstration on my part that if we can all do our bit as individuals we will without doubt make progress , I applaud you for doing your bit and setting an example on meat reduction usage.

In the meantime Jocelyn and Chris have laid out their thoughts so nothing to add beyond that which could be useful at this point in time . We will continue to do our bit in progressing any possibilities and bringing people along with collective goals and ideas

I am genuinely worried about the climate emergency will affect me and the people I love. To be honest I am concerned for all life on earth.

The latest report from the IPCC says we are on code red. We face an existential threat, I want everyone to act right now. So please understand my frustration on the request for MTC to recommend that each new build should have a washing line to reduce power consumption. It seems such a tiny affordable step. Chris I felt that you were trying to catch me out and did not believe me when I stated that we had increased the vegan/vegetarian options on my menu. It's about a mental change that is needed and I hoped MTC would do showing leadership by nudging people into doing the right thing.

A great start would be to announce that MTC recommends that new homes should have a washing line and that MTC are returning free staff parking and replacing them with a bike rack. Please do reconsider your objections to these.
