This notice must be delivered to Marlow Town Council, Court Garden, Pound Lane, Marlow, Bucks SL7 2AG giving at least **3 clear working days' notice** of the Interment.

Please note: Interments on weekdays after 3.00pm or on a Saturday are by special arrangement only.

Transfer of Ownership

Only the owner of a grave space can arrange an interment within that grave space. The owner of a grave space, once deceased, has the right to be buried in the grave space. No Grant of Exclusive Right of Burial can be transferred until the proposed successor can provide proof positive of their right to have the Grant transferred into their name/s (minimum of 2 and maximum of 4). This process is explained in "Transfer of Ownership - Guidance"

ALL NEW FULL BURIALS WILL TAKE PLACE IN SECTION G

Please note that **HEADSTONES ONLY** are permitted in Section G. All flowers will be removed two weeks after the funeral has taken place (this applies to ALL sections, not just Section G). Once the soil on the grave has settled, the plot will be left flat and grassed over. It is not permissible to place or plant any flowers or other items on the graves in this section other than in **VASES BUILT INTO THE HEADSTONE PLINTH**.

Marlow Town Council will provide a small aluminium vase until such a time that the grave has settled. The vase will be positioned in the place of a headstone by the Cemetery Superintendent and must not be moved to another position. If a headstone is then installed, the vase, which remains the property of Marlow Town Council, must be returned to the Cemetery Superintendent.
