EW.47.24 Marlow Football Club Wall Mural Project

The Marlow Football Club has granted permission for an MTC-led project to paint the exterior wall of their facility along the Trinity Court - Oak Tree Road footpath. A section of the wall is to be left for the Marlow Football Club to contribute their own artwork.

Details of the Project:

- The painting will be completed in small manageable sections, with careful preparation of the area, including ground & wall vegetation clearance. The clearance work to be completed by the payback team when available.
- The wall will be prepped with primer before any artwork is applied.
- Cllr Stapley proposes speaking to Marlow schools to design and contribute a section of the mural, fostering local community involvement and creative expression.
- The school/artist-designed murals will be sealed, with a graffiti-proof sealant to protect the wall from future vandalism and preserve the artwork.
- Cllr Stapley would like to propose an allocation of £1,000 from the Environment & Wellbeing budget for this project. This budget will cover materials, sealant and any other associated costs. The Environment committee to establish a budget line for maintenance of £300 per annum for future years.

Recommended:

That members agree to the Marlow Football Club Wall Mural Project and the allocation of £1,000 from the Environment & Wellbeing budget for materials and an allocation of £300 per annum budget line for maintenance and/or repairs.
